

# **ST. PAUL'S CEMETERY GUIDELINES**

**Jul 13, 1999 Voters' Assembly**

## **From March 1 to March 15**

NO DECORATIONS OF ANY KIND – This is to give the trustees time to clean up cemeteries before spring. If you have decorations you wish to retain, please remove them before march 1 or the trustees will.

## **From March 15 to October 1**

ONLY CUT FLOWERS OR SMALL ARTIFICIAL BOUQUET will be permitted as grave decorations. One per grave and these placed in regular sunken vases or metal containers next to monument or marker. The top of container must be level with the ground, so mower will not hit it.

## **EXCEPTIONS TO THE ABOVE**

### **Easter - Mother's Day - Memorial Day**

At these times, other appropriate decorations may be used for ONE (1) WEEK ONLY.

### **(Boxes - Potted Plants - Wreaths, Etc.)**

### **At the end of one week, please remove or trustees will.**

However, please use no glass or pottery containers at any time. Also, use no pieces of wire, rocks, or anything similar to anchor a basket or wreath. These are very dangerous and have caused many injuries and have been known to kill people when thrown from under a mower or trimmer.

## **From October 1 to March 1**

Any appropriate winter decorations may be used such as wreaths, blankets, artificial flowers, etc. No boxes with glass covering at any time. No artificial wreaths tied to stones at any time. When flowers become faded, please remove or trustees will.
